

**CITY OF MARSHALL
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

The City Council of the City of Marshall will conduct a public hearing at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, April 20, 2026, in the Council Chambers of Marshall City Hall, 323 W Michigan Ave, on the following items:

- Amendment to ordinance 132.01 Threats; assault and battery. An update that separates assault and battery offenses from threat offenses and aligns the assault and battery and 93 day penalty verbiage with the state law.
- Amendment to ordinance 132.02 Harassing Communications. An update that adds cellphone, computers, and electronic communications to the ordinance and adds origination and termination language to align with established state law.
- Amendment to ordinance 134.04 Disorderly Conduct. An update that removes outdated protected speech “vagrancy” and “begging” while also adding additional definitions for disorderly conduct including prostitution, illegal gambling, illegal sale of intoxicating liquor to help align the disorderly ordinance with the disorderly house ordinance.
- Amendment to ordinance 134.03 Disorderly House. An update that simplifies and streamlines the ordinance to align with the disorderly conduct ordinance by moving the definitions under the disorderly ordinance.
- Addition of Ordinance 122 Mobile Food Vending. An Ordinance to establish permit requirements, fees, general requirements, fire inspections, and violation penalties and to repeal any conflicting ordinances and codes.

The public is encouraged to make their viewpoint on the matter known at the public hearing or beforehand through letter mailed to the City Clerk’s Office, 323 West Michigan Street, Marshall, MI 49068 or electronic mail to meubank@cityofmarshall.com. All communications should be addressed to the City Council.
