SUBJECT: **APPOINTMENT OF ELECTION OFFICIALS**

The state requires that the municipal Election Commission meet to appoint the Election Inspectors for every election. By law, a minimum of 3 inspectors is required per precinct, but Marshall has found 5-6 per precinct to be the most effective for a local election. The proposed list of election inspectors contains mainly those who have been inspectors for Marshall for years, as well as some experienced inspectors that we are borrowing from Battle Creek due to vacations of our usual inspectors.

BUDGET IMPACT:

Regardless of who is appointed, all inspectors make \$12/hour and chairpeople make \$13/hour.

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the list of election inspectors as submitted to meet the July 18, 2023 submission deadline as set by the state.
